ADVISORY

In compliance to the advisory received from Lok Bhawan vide Letter No. GSA.44/2025/116 dated 13.05.2026, and in view of the prevailing global fuel crisis, as well as the appeal made by the Hon'ble Prime Minister of India for conservation and judicious utilisation of fuel and other natural resources, all stakeholders of **Krishnaguru Adhyatmik Visvavidyalaya** are hereby requested to extend their sincere cooperation in promoting sustainable, responsible, and energy-efficient practices across the University campus.

All teaching and non-teaching staff, officers, students, research scholars, and other stakeholders are urged to adopt conscious and responsible measures to minimise unnecessary consumption of fuel, electricity, water, and other resources. In this regard, the following measures are recommended for compliance to the extent possible:

1. Prefer the use of public transport, carpooling, cycling, or walking for daily commuting wherever feasible.
2. Avoid unnecessary use of official and personal vehicles within the University campus.
3. Ensure prudent and need-based utilisation of institutional resources and avoid avoidable expenditure.
4. Use air-conditioners only when absolutely necessary and maintain the temperature setting at not below 25°C.
5. Switch off lights, fans, air-conditioners, computers, and other electrical and electronic appliances when not in use.
6. Promote energy-efficient and environmentally responsible practices in offices, departments, laboratories, hostels, and residential areas.
7. Conserve water and prevent wastage of natural and other essential resources.
8. Encourage awareness, sensitivity, and responsible behaviour towards environmental sustainability among all members of the University community.
9. Conduct seminars, workshops, meetings, and other academic or administrative activities in online mode wherever feasible to reduce resource consumption.
10. Avoid foreign and air travel to the extent possible unless absolutely necessary.

The University firmly believes that collective responsibility and sincere participation by every member of the University fraternity can make a meaningful contribution towards resource conservation, environmental protection, and the larger national interest.

All concerned are, therefore, requested to take this advisory seriously and ensure its compliance in both letter and spirit.
