Dear aspirants, for quality education, we welcome you all to Krishnaguru Adhyatmik Visvavidyalaya, the brain child of His Holiness Krishnaguru Ishwar for the all-inclusive growth of your personalities blended with spiritual training with up-to-date learning for living successful life with prosperity and peace. The Prospectus of Krishnaguru Adhyatmik Visvavidyalaya, is the reflection of the University established as per the Assam Act No. XXVI of 2017, (Received the assent of the Governor on 6th April, 2017) KRISHNAGURU ADHYATMIK VISVAVIDYALAYA ACT, 2017. The university is functional as per the specified Act as well as ASSAM ACT NO. XII OF 2007 (Received the assent of Governor on 30th April, 2007) - THE ASSAM PRIVATE UNIVERSITIES ACT, 2007. Thus, the University is administered and managed as per the guidelines of the specified two Acts as well as the Guidelines of the University Grants Commission. After having recognition by the University Grants Commission under Section 2(F), Vide Letter No F. No 8-24/2018(CPP-I/PU) Date: November 15, 2019, the toil and vision of His Holiness, Krishnaguru Ishwar for Higher Education of the masses of the very remotest area, became a reality.

Parallel to the dispersal of Krishnaguru Name (Krishnaguru Naam) to the Bhakatas and followers, Paramguru Krishnaguru Ishwar, from the year 1974, has made the provision of 'Krishnaguru Akhanda Ek Nam Kirtan' (Krishnaguru Ceaseless One Name Carousal) for 'World Peace'. To realize and follow by all of the World, he has forwarded twenty Speeches, so as to remove enmity and ill-feelings. One of the preachings of His holiness Paramguru Krishnaguru Ishwar, is – 'slender to religion, slender to self, slender to a votary and the campaigners of untruth pollute the air. Polluted air increases in community and taking such air men become ignorant and harm society. Revolt starts in the country. Majority of people by being involved in evil deeds destroys peace in the world. My blessings are there to them – may almighty impart them virtuous knowledge.' Thus, He felt the urgency of up-to-date education mingled with spiritualism. He always emphasized on the spread of knowledge for the unity, integrity, prosperity and peaceful world order. All His blissful thoughts have been revived in the Educational packages of all the institutions. For the realization of the Educational Philosophy of His Holiness, Paramguru Krishnaguru Ishwar, the innovative curricula blended with spiritualism as emphasized in the National Policy on Education: 2020, was familiarized many years back by establishing the Krishnaguru Mahavidyalaya in the year 1992 at Krishnaguru Sewashram.

In addition to the courses of Arts & humanities, Science and Commerce, since the year 2018, three year General Nursing and Midwifery (GNM) Course against Sixty Seats and since the year 2019, four year B.Sc. Nursing Course against Sixty seats are continuing.

The Institute of Physiotherapy, under Krishnaguru Adhyatmik Visvavidyalaya was established in the year 2019 with the blessings of Krishnaguru Prabhu Iswar where four year Bachelor of Physiotherapy (BPT) Course is available.

Since the year 2024, the Pharmacy College has been permitted to become functional by the Pharmacy Council of India (PCI) where D. Pharm & B. Pharm courses against sixty seats in each are continuing.

Krishnaguru Adhyatmik Visvavidyalaya has been making and planned to make provision of Teacher Training courses like B. Ed., M. Ed., D. El. Ed, and Skill generating courses consisting of Computer Application, Welding, Plumbing, Electrician & Fitter, Mushroom Production, Floriculture, Nursery Training Course, Pisciculture etc.

Dear stakeholders, since the time of establishment, the University and its constituent institutions have been successful in providing all conversant educational facilities without compromise of the quality parameter and have been successful in helping students for doing good results and secure ranks.

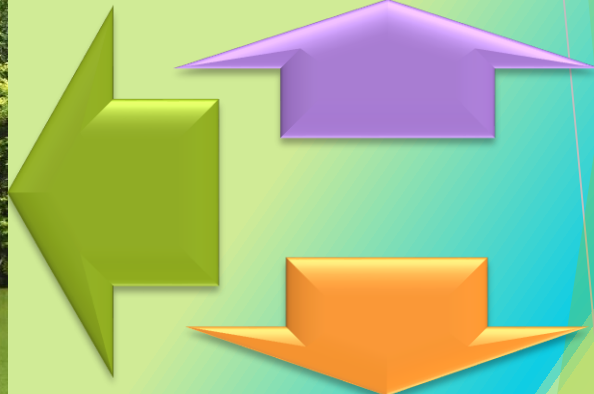

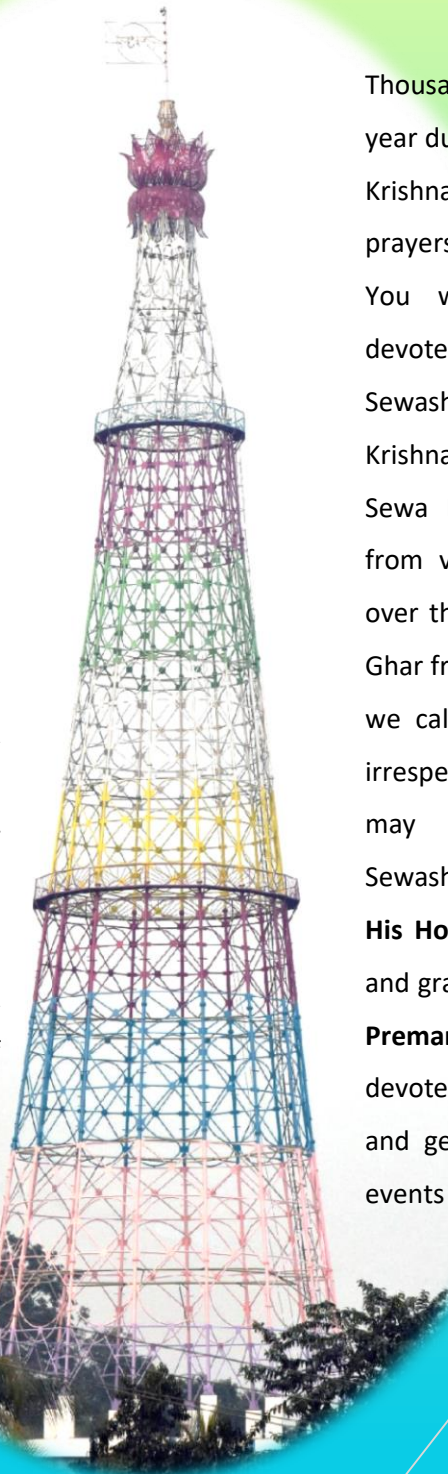

The Department of Pharmacy was established at Krishnaguru Adhyatmik Visvavidyalaya in the year 2024 with the prime objective of providing the best pharmacy education in the lower part of Assam and North-East region of India, to develop efficient & confident pharmacy professionals by imparting professional knowledge while giving them the appropriate practical hands-on experience of the field, to maintain the pharmaceutical education at par with the other leading institutes providing similar education in the field, an up-to-date research in order to provide technical standards and manpower in the area of pharmacy, and, also to promote research and development activities, social harmony and peace in health care system in North East India.

The Department of Pharmacy at Krishnaguru Adhyatmik Visvavidyalaya Nasatra, had simultaneously introduced two main courses in the stream; the first one is the Diploma in Pharmacy and second one is the Bachelor of Pharmacy courses. Each Diploma and the Bachelor course having an intake capacity of 60 students every year. The Pharmacy Courses are duly approved by the concerned governing bodies namely the Pharmacy Council of India (PCI). 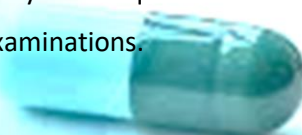

ELIGIBILITY

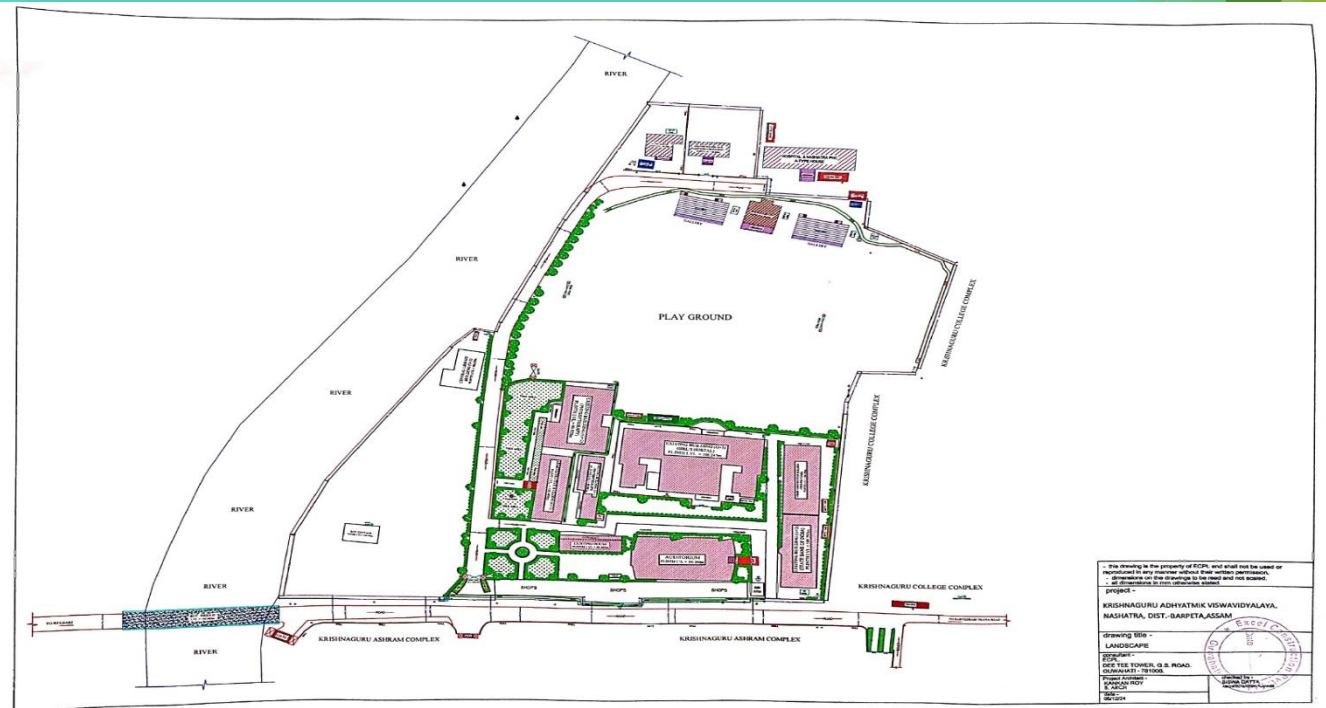

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

GENERAL GUIDELINES

1. Candidates are required to read the prospectus carefully before filling up the Application form.
2. Candidates having minimum marks as mentioned in the prospectus, will be considered for admission on merit basis.
3. The applicant desiring to apply in more than one course shall submit his/her preference in the same application form.
4. The candidates who have appeared in the qualifying examination but whose results have not been declared may also apply for admission. But they need to submit their results before admission.

PICK UP YOUR APPLICATION FORM

1. Candidates seeking admission to any course during the academic session 2023-2024 may obtain the application form along with the prospectus from the Counter of Krishnaguru Adhyatmik Visvavidyalaya, Nasatra, Barpeta, Assam on cash payment of 300/- only.
2. The application form may also be downloaded from the University's official website: www.kav.ac.in and need to be submitted along with the prescribed fee of 300/- only. In such case the prospectus can be collected during the submission of the form.
3. No other fees is required to be submitted at the time of submission of the application form.

SUBMIT YOUR APPLICATION FORM

1. The filled-up application form should be submitted to the Office of the Registrar on or before last date of submission of application form. Application forms will be accepted between 9:30 am to 5:00 pm (except lunch hours) in all working days. The University remains closed on Tuesday.
2. The application fee is non-refundable and no correspondence on this subject will be entertained.
3. Three recent (passport size) coloured photographs should be affixed on the application form. Photographs are to be pasted with gums and should not be stapled or pinned. Application form with different photographs are liable to be rejected.
4. Candidates are required to fill the application form with BLACK ink in his/her own handwriting.
5. Application forms must be filled in and duly signed by the applicant. Incomplete application forms shall be summarily rejected.
6. The last dates of submission of application forms for each of the courses will be notified from time to time in the Notice Board and in University's Website www.kav.ac.in

Online form fill up and submission may also be done on our website: www.kav.ac.in on submission of prescribed fee of 300/- online.

MODE OF SELECTION

Admissions will be based on Merit (percentage secured in the last qualifying examination) and personal interview.



CODE OF ETHICS

The students of the University are expected to maintain the highest standards of discipline in a dignified manner inside as well as outside the University campus with personal, academic and professional integrity. They shall abide by the Rules and Regulations of the University and should act in the way that highlights the discipline and esteem of the University.

1. Students of KAV cultivates a basic Spiritual orientation that contributes to the development of a healthy personality. They should have respect for all religion and should actively participate in assembly prayer.
2. All the students of the University must wear their Identity Cards, well displayed at all times when on the University campus. The loss of the Identity Card, whenever it occurs, shall immediately be reported in writing to the KAV Office.
3. Ragging is a punishable offence. Harassing juniors, ill treatment to other fellow students or any such form of ragging is strictly prohibited, shall be met with zero tolerance and liable to be treated as criminal offence.
4. Substance abuse such as tobacco, alcohol, drugs etc. is strictly prohibited in the campus. Consumption of intoxicants/psychotropic substances in any form or smoking are totally banned.
5. All students must abide by the dress code stipulated by the University. Any dress code violation noticed within the campus will attract a fine of ₹500/- (Rupees Five Hundred).
6. The students are required to keep their phones in silent/vibrating mode on the campus. Any student(s) using mobile phone during class hours/ other academic activities shall be liable to a fine of ₹500/- (Rupees Five Hundred).
7. Irregularity in attendance, persistent idleness or negligence or indifference towards work assigned may invite penalty, violates disciplines and rules of the University.
8. Political activity in any form is not permitted in the University Campus. Unauthorized meetings, propaganda work, processions or fund collections are forbidden within the University.
9. Using electronic or other means to make any audio/video or photographic object/record of any person is prohibited without prior knowledge/permission of the person/authority concerned. Any violation of the above rules will invite penalty in the form of warning, fine, expulsion from the University/Hostel etc. as deemed appropriate by the competent authority of the University.

Violation of Discipline shall include:

1. Causing disturbance to classes, offices, libraries, auditorium, playground etc.
2. Disobeying the instructions of teachers or the authorities.
3. Misconduct or misbehaviour of any nature at the examination Centre, or at meetings or during curricular or extra-curricular activities of the University.
4. Misconduct or misbehaviour of any nature towards a teacher or any employee of the University or any visitor to the University.
5. Causing damage to, spoiling or disfiguring the property/equipment of the University.
6. Visiting places or areas declared by KAV as out of bounds for the students.





ANTI RAGGING POLICY

Ragging is totally prohibited in the University and anyone found guilty of ragging and/or abetting ragging, whether actively or passively, or being a part of conspiracy to promote ragging is liable to be punished in accordance with the UGC regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009 as well as under the panel law for the time being in force.

ESSENTIAL DOCUMENTS AT THE TIME OF ADMISSION

1. The mark-sheets/certificate in accordance with the eligibility requirements for admission must be produced in original at the time of admission.
2. Age proof based on the HSLC or equivalent examination.
3. Character certificate from the institution last attended.
4. In case an intervening period/gap is involved an affidavit from Notary Public for the entire intervening period/gap showing candidate's pre occupation and non indulgence in any criminal activities after leaving the institution last attended will be required.
5. It is the sole responsibility of the candidate to ensure his/her eligibility before applying for admission to a particular course. No claim of any shortage in this matter shall be entertained.
6. Applicants are advised to read all the instructions given in the prospectus carefully before filling up the application form.

RULES RELEVANT TO ADMISSION

1. List of selected students shall be displayed on the Notice Board of the University as well as in KAV's website, www.kav.ac.in
The candidate shall be required to get their admission completed by the date given in the schedule.
2. Admission will be allowed only after due verification of all original documents by the verifying officer of the University.
3. All the candidates are required to submit Transfer Certificate/Migration Certificate in original within 45 days from the date of admission, failing which the admission of the student is liable to be cancelled.
4. The candidate shall take admission on payment of prescribed admission fee given in the fee structure in the Accounts Branch of Krishnaguru Adhyatmik Visva Vidyalaya, Nasatra, Barpeta, Assam.
5. If the candidate fails to complete the admission formalities by the prescribed date, he/she will automatically forfeit his/her right of admission.
6. Admission of a candidate may be cancelled at any time, if any information furnished at the time of admission is found to be incorrect or that the candidate has been wrongly admitted due to any reason.
